



Dear agent:

As you know, ACORD has made changes to the Certificates of Insurance, and this notice is being sent to provide clarification on the Fund's position.

The ABC WC SIF is authorized to do business as a qualified self insurer in the State of TN, providing Statutory Workers' Compensation and Employers' Liability.

The ABC WC SIF does not issue a policy; therefore, endorsements are not available. As a reminder, waiver of subrogation is available to the Fund's Members, but we will always require notice of any and all waivers; a copy of the COI would be sufficient.

The cancellation provision is contained in the Indemnity Agreement (IA) which is a part of each Member's contract of insurance. The IA provides for a 10 day notice of cancellation in the event of non payment, and a 60 day notice in the event of non renewal on the part of the ABC WC SIF. A copy of the Fund's IA is available on the website, www.abcsif.com.

If the Member's contract requires notice of any kind concerning the cancellation of a Member or the non renewal of a Member, it is the responsibility of the issuer of the certificate of insurance to provide the notice to the certificate holder.
